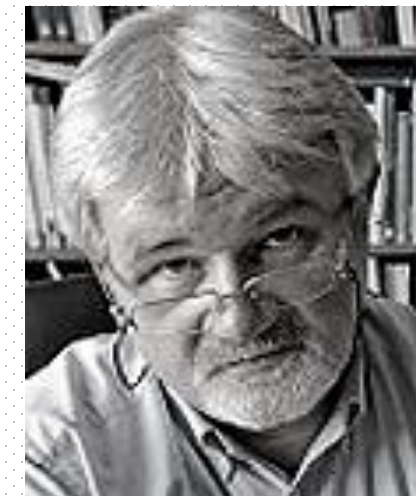
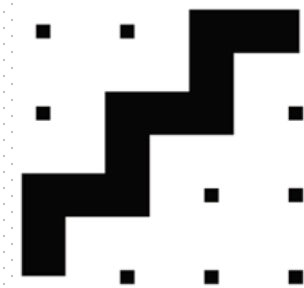

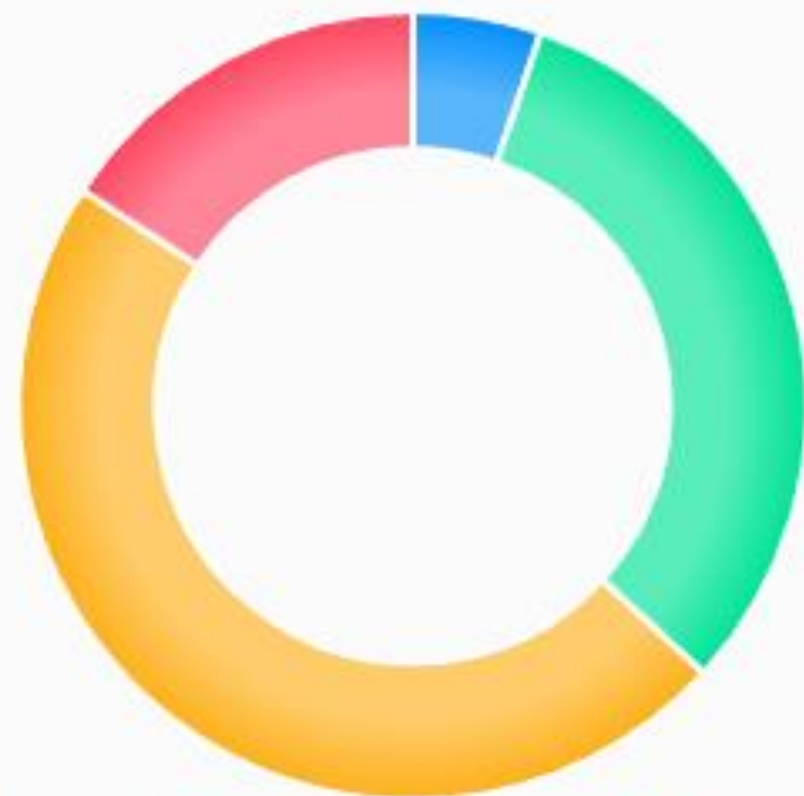

TÁRKI's HorizonEU projects

EUROSHIP (lead: OsloMet)

2020-2023

- assessment of the current gaps in social protection against poverty and social exclusion in Europe.
- aimed to develop policy recommendations on how to strengthen social citizenship at the national and EU level.
- TÁRKI: indicators of poverty and social exclusion in Europe and their changes, and to recommend new indicators to measure the implementation of social rights in Europe. The research culminated in a series of book publications.

UPLIFT (lead: Metropolitan Research Institute)

2020-2023

- innovative approach to urban policy design for reducing socio-economic inequalities. UPLIFT followed a multi-layer research method to map the processes and drivers of urban inequality.
- TÁRKI's task was to examine the dimensions and drivers of urban inequalities and then to develop a methodology.

PIONEERED (Lead: LISER)

2021-2024

- Pioneerered looks at educational inequalities to reduce them. The project aims to propose research-informed policy measures and to identify pioneering policies and practices to enhance access to, uptake and completion of education.
- TÁRKI is to explore good practice in promoting equality in education in Hungary, to conduct expert interviews, two focus groups organize workshops, etc.

KIDS4ALL (Lead: UNITO)

2021-2024

- A pilot action that experienced a method and learning environment in formal, non-formal and informal educ. contexts to address the integration challenges of migrant, ethnic minority children in nine countries.
- Tárki manily worked on the development of, testing and assessing an innovative educational material closely together with an after-school facility for disadvantaged Roma children.

TÁRKI's HorizonEU projects

SPES 2023-2025

The aim of the SPES project is to generate new knowledge and evidence about the **nexus between economic growth, human flourishing and sustainability**, contributing to the creation and uptake of a novel integrated framework fostering the transition towards the sustainable human development in European countries and regions. The SPES project focusing its attention, both theoretically and empirically, on the four pillars of the sustainable human development: a) Productivity, b) Equality for all, c) Sustainability, d) Participation and empowerment.

STRIDE 2024-2027

STRIDE will provide a new, comprehensive and comparative knowledge-base on effective education reforms, policy initiatives and interventions aimed at reducing inequalities in education, training and learning outcomes in Europe. STRIDE will do this through **analyses of education reforms in national and regional systems**, existing large-scale educational assessment data and existing longitudinal data on the causal link between educational and other social policies and inequalities in educational achievements.

Infra4NextGen 2024-2028

This four-year project will harness outputs from key social science RIs in Europe and other reliable sources to support the aims of the 'Next Generation EU' programme and to inform EU youth policy. Virtual access will be provided to the outputs through special installations (portals) developed during the project. The core of the proposal is a **set of existing research 'services'**, which will be re-purposed and customised to focus directly on the five themes: Make it Green; Make it Digital; Make it Healthy; Make it Strong; and Make it Equal.

TÁRKI's international projects

DECIPHE Research project

2024 -

- DECIPHE (Demographic Change and the Intergenerational Persistence in Homeownership in Europe) is the first project to comprehensively study how profound demographic changes in Europe impact the **intergenerational persistence of homeownership**, considering variations across countries, regions, and birth cohorts.
- DECIPHE is a collaborative project led by Prof. Philippe Lersch (DIW), with the participation of University of Oxford, Centre de Estudis Demografics (Barcelona) and TÁRKI. Financed by the Volkswagen Foundation.

UNHCR Ukrainian refugee survey

2023

- A survey was conducted in the framework of the 2024 Refugee Response Plan (RRP) and was funded by UNHCR and implemented by TÁRKI among Ukrainian refugees in Hungary. The survey covered nearly 700 respondents, who were representing over 1,500 household members. The analysis also included results from 13 focus group discussions.

Power2UAMs (Lead: ELLINIKO SYMBOULIO)

2024 -

- The project aims to ensure equal access to good quality public services to unaccompanied minors (UAMs) at the local level.
- Power2UAMs aims to gather comparable qualitative and quantitative data about the needs of UAMs and their access to services at the local level, then reinforce the coordination among local stakeholders.
- The project will implement activities in 8 localities (Athens, Pyreus, Calais, Brussels, Gent, Liege, Krakow, Warsaw) in 4 countries (Greece, France, Belgium, Poland).

Monitoring Humanitarian Cash Assistance Programme

2024

- UNICEF supported the Municipality of Budapest in establishing the 'Budapest Helps' Cash programme which aimed to support Ukrainian refugee families and children living in Budapest
- Two surveys were conducted among households benefiting, which measured the sustained impact of the cash assistance and their overall well-being.
