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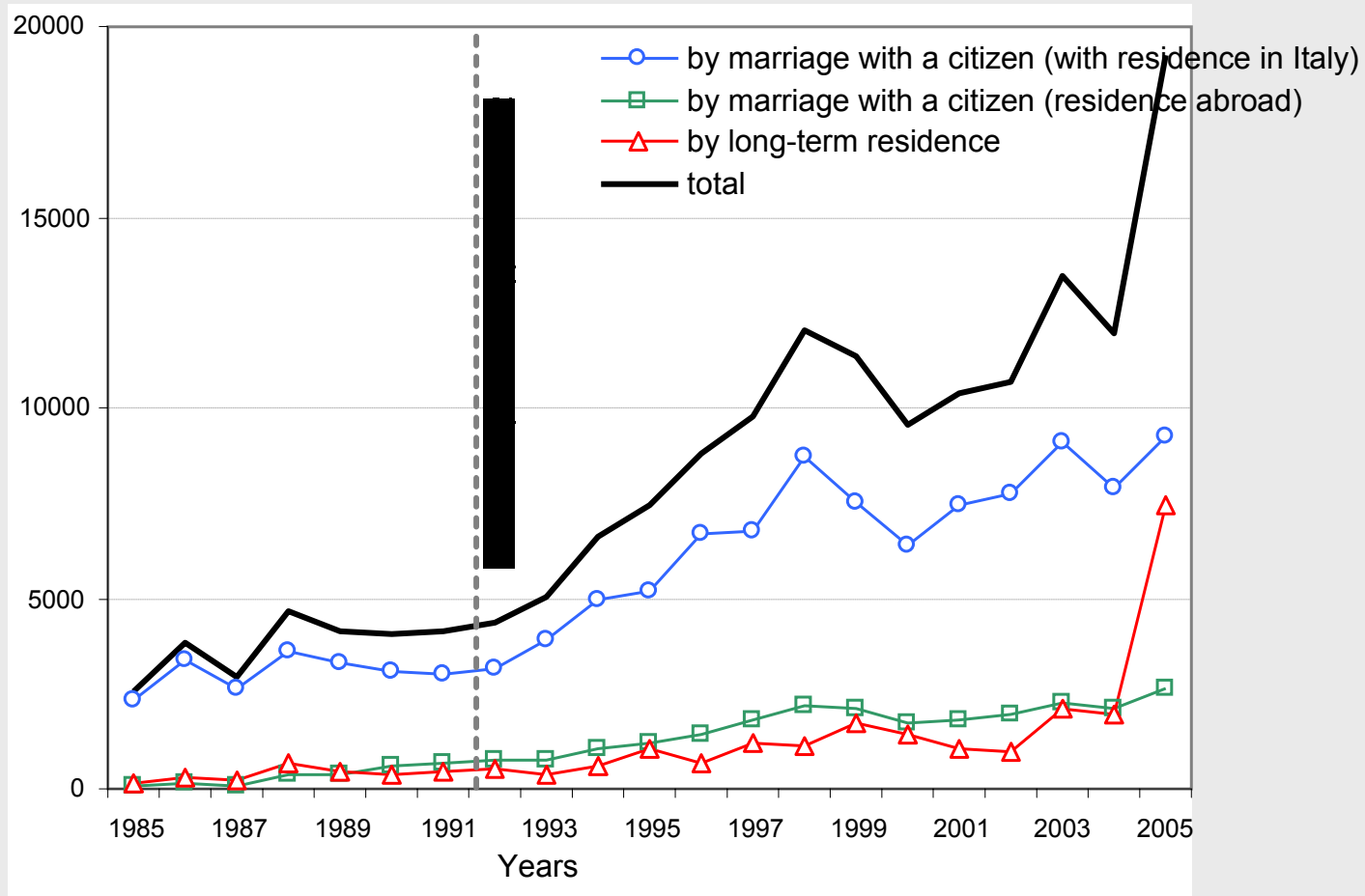

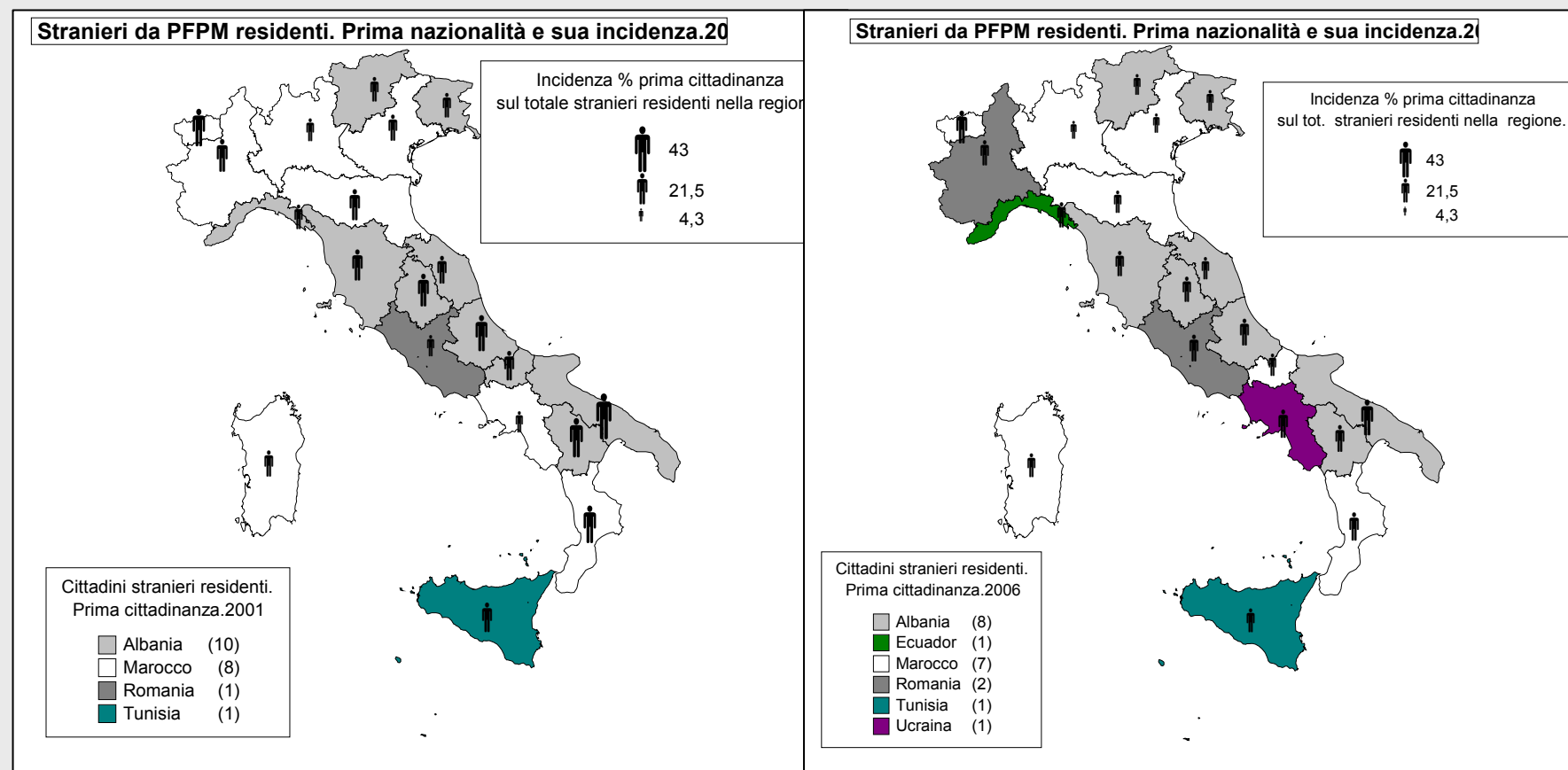

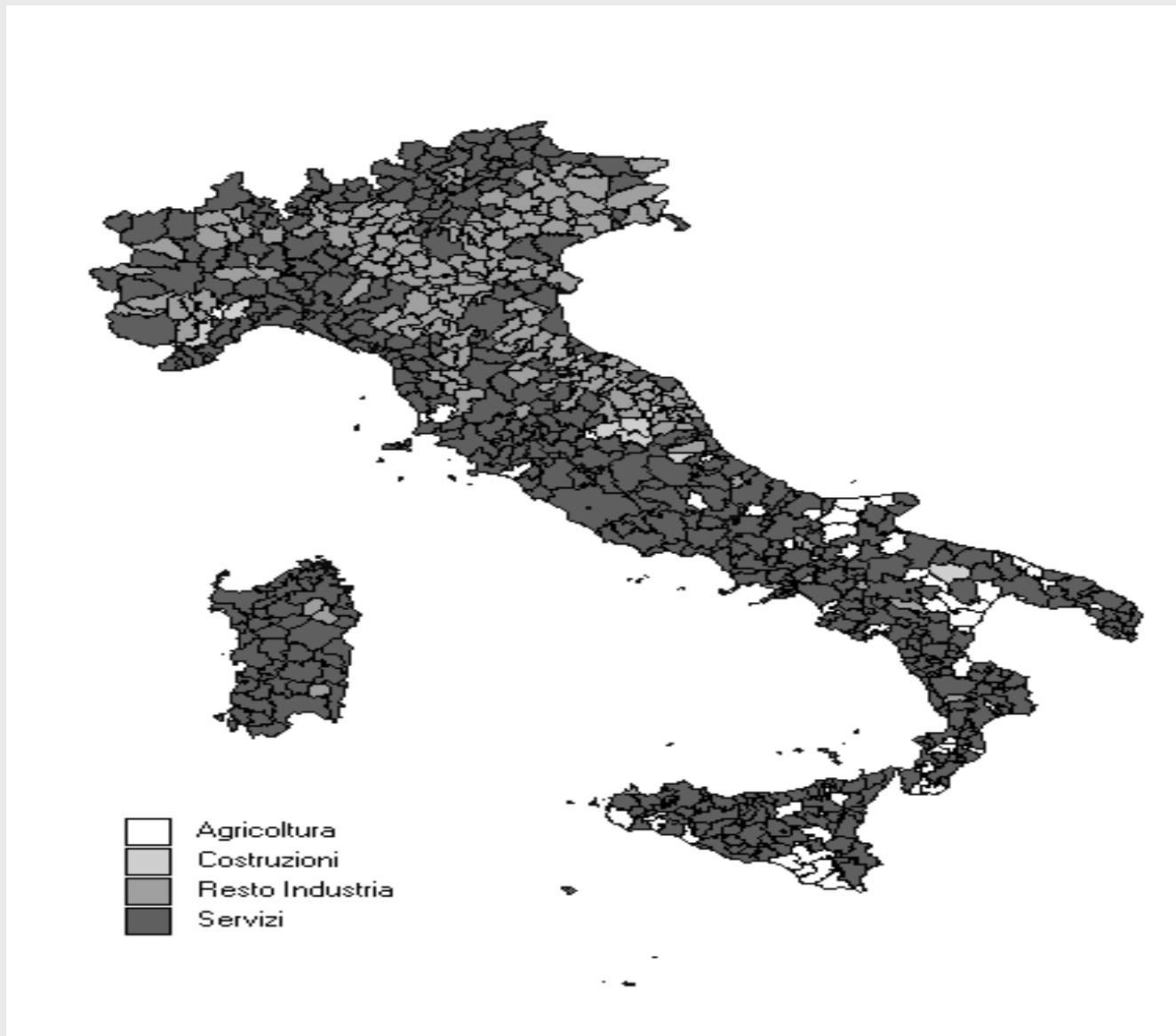

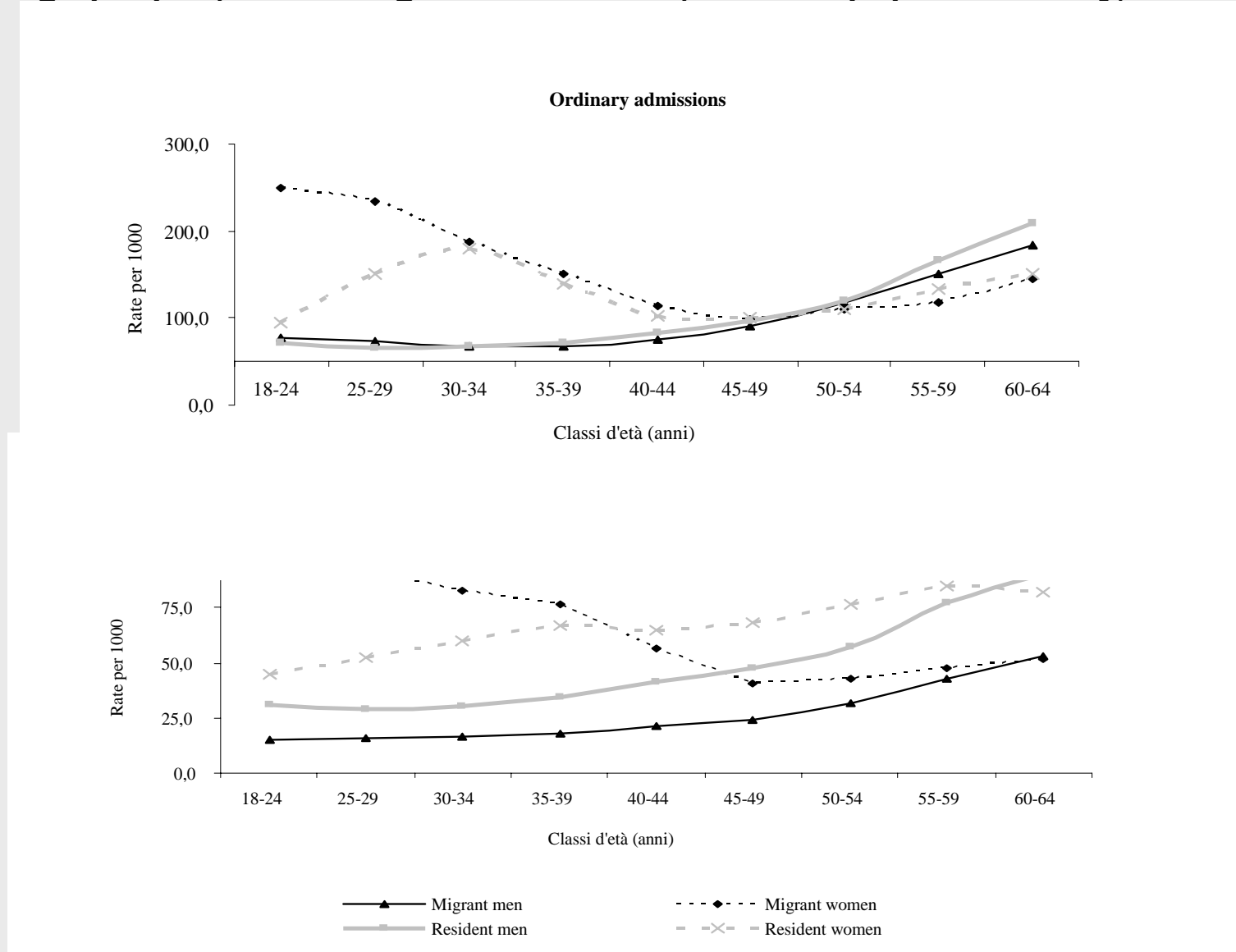

Foreign workers main occupations. Local systems, 2001 Population Census.



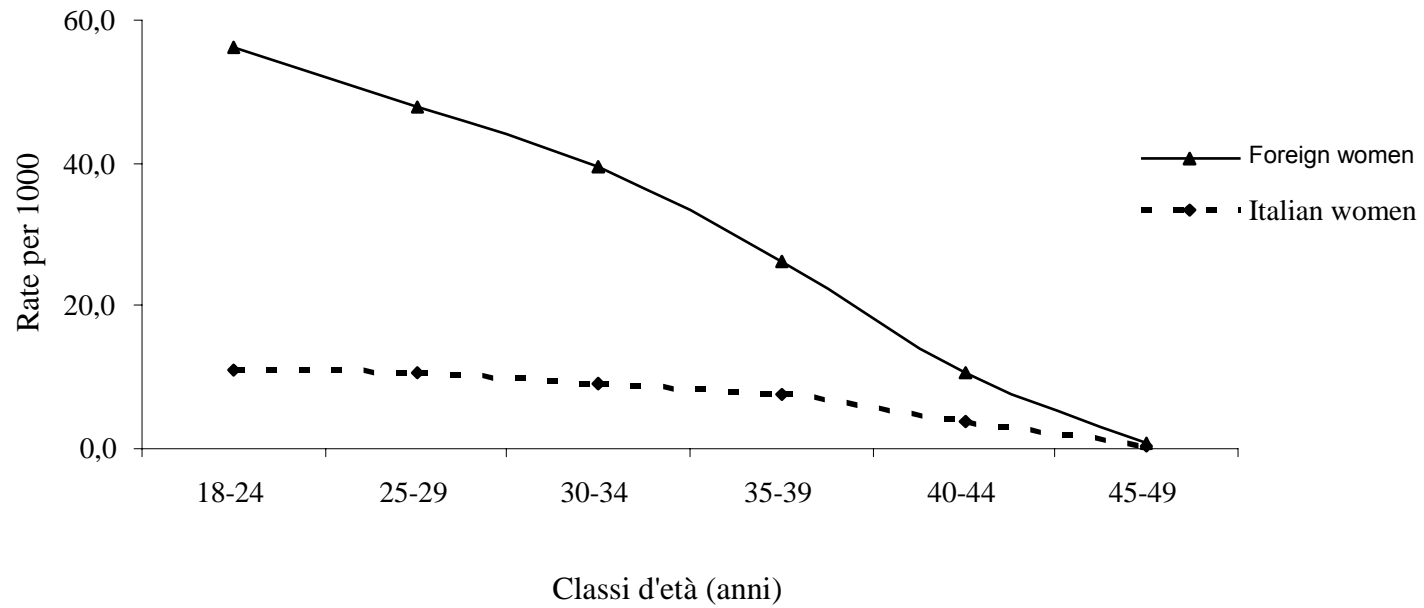
